SAHA İstanbul has made significant progress since its establishment. It has reached a wide network that includes over 1.200 companies, 29 universities, and spans across 45 cities. We regard this broad and rapidly achieved network as highly valuable for our defence ecosystem.

This accomplishment is strengthened through the design, development, and manufacturing of technology, as well as strategic alliances and international collaborations.







SAHA EXPO 2024 International Defence and Aerospace exhibition which stands as the most tangible reflection of Türkiye's domestic and national advancements in the defence industry, was held in Istanbul between 22-26 October. Organized by SAHA Istanbul, the largest industrial cluster in Türkiye and Europe, with the participation of over 1,200 companies and 29 universities, the event took place under the auspices of the Presidency of the Republic of Türkiye and with the participation and support of relevant ministries, as well as civil and military institutions. This year, the exhibition was held under the theme of "Rule the Technology, Shape the Future", strongly supporting SAHA Istanbul's vision of positioning Türkiye as a global power in technology production.

SAHA EXPO 2024 made its mark this year with record-breaking participation and scale. Here are the notable figures from SAHA EXPO 2024:

- **Participation from 121 Countries:** Participation from 121 countries across five continents demonstrated Türkiye's growing position as a global hub.
- **25.944 Participants:** Thousands of exhibitors and sector professionals from various fields gathered for knowledge sharing and collaboration.
- 90.000 sqm Exhibition Space: A vast exhibition area was utilized the showcased, the latest technologies
 and projects in the defence industry. This scale once again demonstrated how rapidly SAHA EXPO has
 grown over the years.
 - In 2018, the exhibition started with 10.000 sqm,
 - In 2021, the exhibition expanded to 40.000 sqm,
 - In 2022, the exhibition grew to 60.000 sgm,
 - And in 2024, the exhibition the exhibition reached to 90.000 sqm.
- **1.478 Exhibitor Companies:** A total of national and international companies participated in the exhibition.
- 22.467 B2B Meetings: Numerous partnerships were established, and projects were initiated.
- **101.367 Visitors:** In addition to sector professionals, the exhibition attracted hundreds of thousands of individuals interested in the sector.



At SAHA EXPO 2024, record-breaking agreements were signed, resulting in a total of \$6.2 billion in commercial agreements, including \$4.6 billion in direct exports. This once again highlighted Türkiye's emergence as a rising power in the global defence industry. The export agreements not only showcase the country's technological superiority in defence but also position Türkiye as a global player in strategic fields such as high-tech unmanned air vehicle, unmanned ground vehicles, naval systems, and cybersecurity solutions.

These collaborations represent not only an economic achievement but also a significant step towards realizing Türkiye's vision of an independent defence industry. SAHA EXPO emphasized Türkiye's commitment to supporting world peace by offering reliable defence solutions to its allies, with each agreement further solidifying Türkiye's position in global security and technological leadership.

Strong Alliances, Strong Türkiye

This year at SAHA EXPO, Ministers from 27 countries, 13 Commander of the Forces, 6 Chiefs of the General Staff, and 6 Secretaries of Defence Industries were hosted. This high-level participation highlighted Türkiye's growing influence in the global defence and aerospace sectors. Through the signing of 133 unique agreements, SAHA EXPO set the groundwork for projects that will provide benefits on a global scale.

Special Events at SAHA EXPO

The special events held at SAHA EXPO this year went beyond a traditional exhibition, offering visitors a more engaging and dynamic experience. Domestically and nationally produced warships and unmanned marine vehicles were displayed at Sarayburnu and Ataköy ports. This exhibition showcased Türkiye's progress in naval defence technologies while offering visitors a unique experience.

SAHA MATCH application, provides participating companies B2B meetings with the right partners for collaboration via a tailored matchmaking program. This inspired hope for the future by enhancing collaborations in the defence industry and creating new opportunities for the sector.





SAHA EXPO emerged as a global hub where all stakeholders of the defence, aviation, and space ecosystem convened, transcending the mere display of products.






















SAHA EXPO 2024 attracted attention with 10.000 sqm open exhibition area, where innovative technologies in the defence industry were exhibited. In this large open area, products currently in the inventory and products newly introduced to the global market were exhibited. The exhibition area, which allows large-scale defence and aerospace projects to meet with visitors, provided an opportunity to closely examine military vehicles, unmanned land and air systems, armored vehicles, and various strategic equipment.



The outdoor exhibition area offered participating companies a platform to present the functionality and applications of their products in more depth. Visitors were able to not only view technological innovations but also experience them firsthand through real-world application demonstrations.

















SAHA EXPO 2024 offered an impressive experience, showcasing Türkiye's vision of independence in the defence industry and its strength in domestic production. In addition to the TCG ISTANBUL Frigate, TCG KINALIADA Corvette, TCG SANCAKTAR Tank Landing Ship, TCG DERYA Naval Supply Combat Support Ship, and TCG Ç-153 Landing Ships of the Turkish Naval Forces, armed unmanned naval vehicles (UAVs) such as 'MARLİN', 'ULAQ' and 'SANCAR', which were built with domestic and national capabilities, shows Türkiye's technological superiority in naval defence to the visitors. Throughout the exhibition, the ships docked at Ataköy and Sarayburnu ports were visited by numerous sector professionals.





















During SAHA EXPO 2024, a joint event was organized by NATO DIANA (Defence Innovation Accelerator for the North Atlantic) and the NATO Innovation Fund (NIF).

Within the scope of the event, an international panel titled 'Leading the Deep Tech Revolution in Defence and Security Domain' was held, where the role of NATO DIANA and NIF in integrating dual-use technologies into the NATO defence ecosystem was discussed, along with their efforts to foster the growth of the entrepreneurial ecosystem.

At the exhibition, NATO DIANA and NIF representatives had the opportunity to review advanced technologies displayed by the participating companies at their booths.

As part of the investor meetings, NIF representatives met with entrepreneurial companies to evaluate investment opportunities.



SAHA EXPO 2024 brought together 1,478 national and international companies from the defence, aviation, and space sectors, ensuring comprehensive industry representation.



SAHA EXPO 2024 created a wide trade platform by hosting commercial procurement delegations from 35 different countries in order to strengthen international cooperation in the defence industry.





Throughout the event, 22,467 B2B meetings between domestic and international companies paved the way for the establishment of strong business partnerships.


The participants of the exhibition had the opportunity to make direct contact with the leading companies of the sector and examine new technologies and trends on site.

The diversity and economic value of these agreements highlighted Türkiye's growing influence in the global defence and aerospace sector, reinforcing its role as a key player on the international stage.















Selçuk Bayraktar, who was a keynote speaker at SAHA EXPO 2024, emphasized Türkiye's goals of independence in the defence industry and shared the significance of the achievements made through the national technology movement.

Selçuk Bayraktar, the Chairman and CTO of Baykar, presented the advancements in unmanned aerial vehicle production and AI applications in this field at SAHA EXPO 2024. He particularly highlighted that the Kızılelma project has ushered in a new era in air combat, stating that the automatic flights conducted by Kızılelma are a sign that unmanned aircraft have the potential to replace manned aircraft in the future. He also emphasized that these efforts have positioned Türkiye as a strong player on the international stage.

Mr.Bayraktar also highlighted the successes in defence industry exports, noting that Baykar has achieved a 65% market share, propelling Türkiye to a leading position in unmanned aerial vehicle exports globally.

Mr.Bayraktar, explaining that artificial intelligence technologies have improved flight safety and autonomous decision-making processes in defence, emphasized the potential of these technologies to reduce human dependency and enhance safety standards.

He expressed that events like Teknofest, which help young people develop their skills in technology and contribute to the national technology movement, are of great importance for the future of the country

He highlighted that developing artificial intelligence technologies should advance within the bounds of ethical values in human relations, stressing that while technology offers great opportunities, it also carries inherent risks for humanity.
